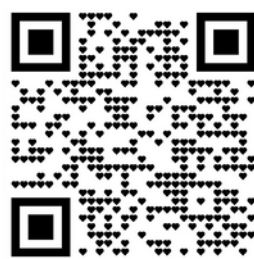
Douglas, Ga, a 14 square mile town, has a 9 acre plant,
Franklin Springs, a 2.1 square mile town, will have a 36 acre plant.

Under the terms of the agreement with Franklin County, Franklin Springs will provide millions of gallons a day of wastewater treatment capacity.

Broad River travels all the way to the Savannah Basin, this will be a massive impact to communities far and wide. It will affect groundwater. It will affect your well water. This will be a massive impact on the health of counties upon counties and we will no longer be able to drink, swim, or fish in these waters.

Mayor Lee Moore has been lying to his community. There are absolute connections with Frank Ginn in this lie. They are trying to move quickly now that we are onto them and they must be stopped now before its too late for the entire Broad River.
